We explore some of our neighbourhood's earliest history, when William Wintle goes 'Exploring Roman Hanney'! His talk will start by looking at some significant pre-Roman (Iron Age) sites and then cover the excavations at Marcham/Frilford, probably the most important Roman site in the Vale. Agricultural workers significantly outnumbered legionaries!

We will then move on to Roman activity and settlement in East Hanney, with a survey from 1967 and more recent development-led excavations such as the one south of Summertown.

Finally, we will tread in more turbulent water with a discussion of the long held "belief" that the A338 was itself a Roman Road.
