

## 2019-2020 TALKS PROGRAMME

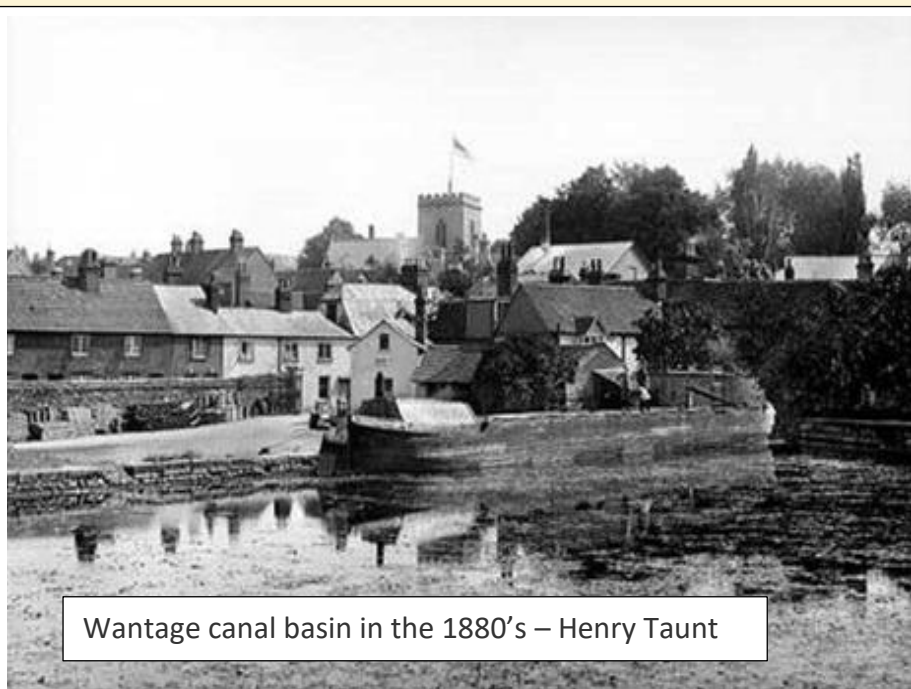
